I pulled the file for our Crest recently to see how long ago we purchased it and was surprised to see that it was about 7 years ago, already! Wow time does fly. I remember the old Thompson Die Cutter that was on the floor and how we were in need of a replacement of the tired machine like it was yesterday. As you know, Valley Container prides itself on having not only the latest efficient machinery on the market but machinery that will last the test of time and perform as intended and marketed.

As you can tell, we are happily still running the Crest you sold us 7 years later. Over that time, we have had operators turn over for the machine and we find the skip feed feature very helpful in the training of the new operators. Additionally, the make ready process was quite tedious on our old press. The Crest requires very little make ready on the operators part. Many times he simply mounts the die, adjusts his pressure and the first strike is 99.9% sellable. This is a great improvement from our old press which required continual buildup to achieve proper cuts.

Just thought I would share a little bit of our satisfaction with the press 7 years after the fact.
